

#selfie -A selfie is a self-portrait photograph, typically taken with a digital camera or camera phone held in the hand or supported by a selfie stick. Selfies are often shared on social networking services such as Facebook, Instagram, SnapChat and Twitter.

Curated by Teresa Lizamore, #selfie is a group painting exhibition that questions and investigates the notions of 'traditional' self-portraiture in a digital realm. The digital realm we often find ourselves in, gives individuals the opportunity to present themselves – or often a selected version of themselves – on various cyber platforms. This has lead to an online revival of the genre of the self-portrait. The popularity of self-portraiture is made possible in part through ubiquitous tools such as web and cell phone cameras. Artists are invited to consider the use, and perhaps the shift, of the self-portrait in a digital age where social media provides the platform for identity formation and how this democratization of self-portraiture has shifted from its original purposes. This exhibition challenges artists to use painting – a medium often seen as 'traditional' – to investigate the shifts in self-portraiture in the digital realms.

Through this exhibition, Lizamore asks of 'painters' to reconsider this idea of the self-portrait with all of the complexity it provides in the context of new media, digital technology and social media platforms through the contrast between the 'instantness' of the digital self-portrait and the labour intensive process of painting.

Portraiture has played a key role in reflecting individuals internal and external worlds and influences. If we consider the adaptation of portraiture for example in Van Gogh's interrogation of the self in his temperamental self-portraits, to Vermeer's portraits of unidentified individuals, e.g. Girl with the pearl earring, to the modern understanding of portraiture through Cindy Sherman, Chuck Close, Lucian Freud, Andy Warhol we see that through the development of society and technology artists have experimented with the representation of 'self'. With the invention of the camera, the focus on new media and a more experimental approach to art making, painting seems to have taken a backseat. Our fascination with the ability to instantly capture the physical form has altered and somehow simplified how we see self-portraiture. The digital has democratized the self-portrait, no longer is it the painstaking, timeous process it previously was. These serve a different purpose to the portrait previously discussed from art history. The digital provides a platform for us to renegotiate our identity, editing, cropping and moulding/curating a visual representation of ourselves through images, links and hashtags with the distinct purpose of being viewed/interrogated by an audience/viewer as they view our page/timeline. The user/ artist plays both subject and author, constructing their own autobiography and linear timeline through their newsfeed.










